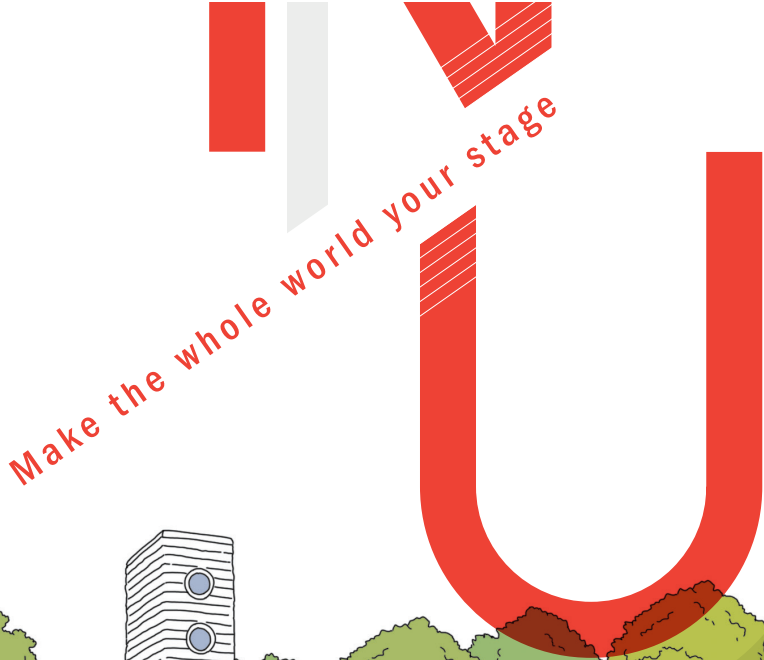

Jeju National University is the one and only national university established in 1952 within the Jeju Special Self-governing Province which is an international city. It consists of 13 colleges, 10 graduate schools including a medical school and a law school as well as other affiliated institutes. There are around 12,200 students enrolled including 980 international students from 37 countries as of the year 2019.

The Korean language course will run for 20 weeks with a focus on comprehensive communication skills, and students will be assigned to each level from 1 to 6 each semester according to the results of the level tests. A group of experienced and professionalized teachers provide a variety of audiovisual education and participate in a variety of cultural activities to help students understand Korean culture in addition to the Korean language courses.

02 Educational Course

- Classes are divided into Beginner(Level 1~2), Intermediate(Level 3~4), and Advanced(Level 5~6), while students are placed at their appropriate level based on preliminary level test results.
- Number of students per class : 15~20 students
- Classes are reorganized according to the exam results after 200 hours of study during the semester
- Criteria for completion : Students must have attended more than 80% of their total hours of classes with a grade point average of more than 60 points on their exam results in addition to having no classes of less than 40 points. (Exception applied only to the Speaking Class in level 1)
- For Beginner level, "Practical Korean for Foreign Students(제대로 한국어)" published by Jeju National University will be used.



03 Responsibilities

Language program students and international students must have student insurance and information will be given for enrolling in group insurance after admission into the program.

04 Special Benefits for the Korean Language Program Students

Scholarship will be given to students with superior grades and those who won the speech contest.

05 Short-term Korean Language & Culture Program

It will be run separately from the regular program.

Scholarships

After being admitted into the undergraduate program, in the case where a certain grade is achieved, a full or partial amount of the tuition as designated by the university standard will be given out as scholarships to the students.

Part-time Work for International Students

Eligible Students

- Language program students(Visa type D-4) who have been studying here for more than 6 months as well as international students and exchange students(Visa type D-2).

Allowed Time Limit

- In the case of freshmen and sophomores(1st & 2nd year students), TOPIK level 3 is required, while juniors/seniors(3rd & 4th year students) as well as masters/doctoral students need TOPIK level 4 for them to be allowed to work up to 20 hours per week (Masters/Doctoral students can work up to 30 hours a week).
 - * If students do not have TOPIK level, undergraduate students can work up to 10 hours.(Masters/ Doctoral students 15 hours)
 - * If Korean language program students have a TOPIK level, they can work up to 20 hours and up to 10 hours if they have no TOPIK level.
- Public Holidays & Vacation Period: No time limit(The hours remain the same for Korean language program students)
