Others	○ Those who have a high school diploma can apply within a year after graduation.

※ If any document is written in other languages, it should be attached with translation in Korean or English.

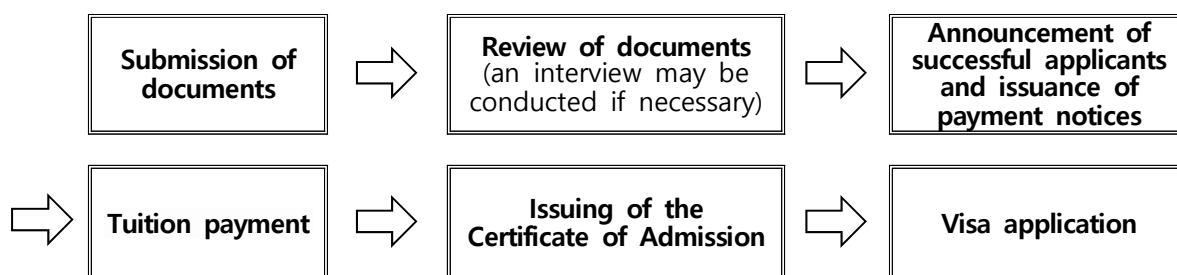
